1. As used in these Conditions of Sale, the term "the final bid" means the highest bid acknowledged by the auctioneer, and the term "the purchase price" means the sum of the final bid and the premium payable by the buyer under Condition 4.

2. The highest bidder acknowledged by the auctioneer shall be the buyer of the lot offered for sale, subject to the terms set forth in these Conditions of Sale. The auctioneer has the right to reject any bid, to advance the bidding at his absolute discretion, and, in the event of any dispute between bidders, to determine the successful bidder or to reoffer and resell the lot in dispute. **GUM:** Original gum is not to be expected on Nineteenth Century Issues unless so stated in the description.

Original gum should be expected on Twentieth Century Issues unless stated otherwise in the description.

o.g.	unused with original gum showing slight disturbance caused by previous hinge, which may be present in part or entirely removed
hinge mark	original gum showing evidence of hinge removal, including but not limited to redistributed gum in the area of hinging
part o.g.	unused with original gum significantly disturbed or heavily hinged
never hinged	original gum as issued by the post office

**COVERS:** should be expected to have minor nicks and tears usually from opening. Folded letters or covers normally have one or two file folds. These are not described unless of an exceptional nature and are not grounds for return.

folded letter	complete as sent with comments still attached to the outer address portion
folded cover	the outer portion of a folded letter but without contents
cover	an envelope

**GRADES:** The following terms are used to grade centering for United States stamps, both perforated and imperforate.

extremely fine	near perfect centering, reserved for the most exceptional examples
very fine	well-centered, satisfies the requirements of most particular collectors
fine	design intact although perforations or margins may touch the design on some issues
very good	perforation slightly in on one or two sides
good	off-centered or fairly attractive with slight defects

The application of these terms to stamped covers is meant to convey the overall condition and appearance of a particular item, rather than the grade of the stamp or stamps. With respect to stampless covers, the clarity of the markings is the basis for grading.

**5c Deep Blue (unlisted)**, tied by sharp 'Rep. de Cuba.' double-line oval handstamp, matching Havana Apr. 25 datestamp on fresh 1896 yellow cover to S. D. Tomas E. Palma at New York, black 'T' in circle, purple 'Paquebot/(N.Y.F.D. Div.)' handstamp, 'Collect/Postage/10 Cents' straightline, U.S. 10c Postage Due tied by New York duplex, May 4 receiving backstamps, small part of backflap intact

This cover is the earliest recorded use of insurrection force stamps, which were issued on April 4, 1896. While prepayment was recognized by Cuban postal officials at Havana, evidently the New York post office considered this letter unpaid and charged 10c due on arrival. The addressee on this cover, S. D. Tomas Estrada Palma, later published a plea to the U.S. post office to recognize the revolutionary government and its postage stamps. Palma was the representative of the Cuban Republic at this time and later became the first President of an independent Cuba in 1902.

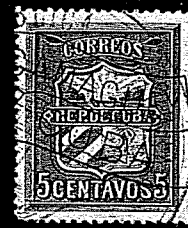

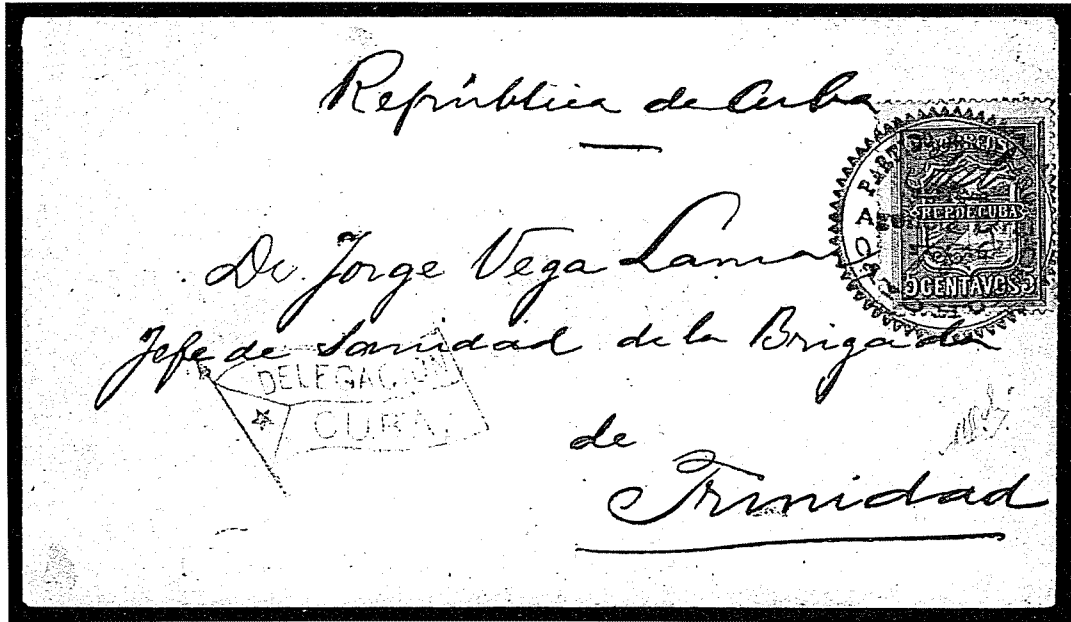

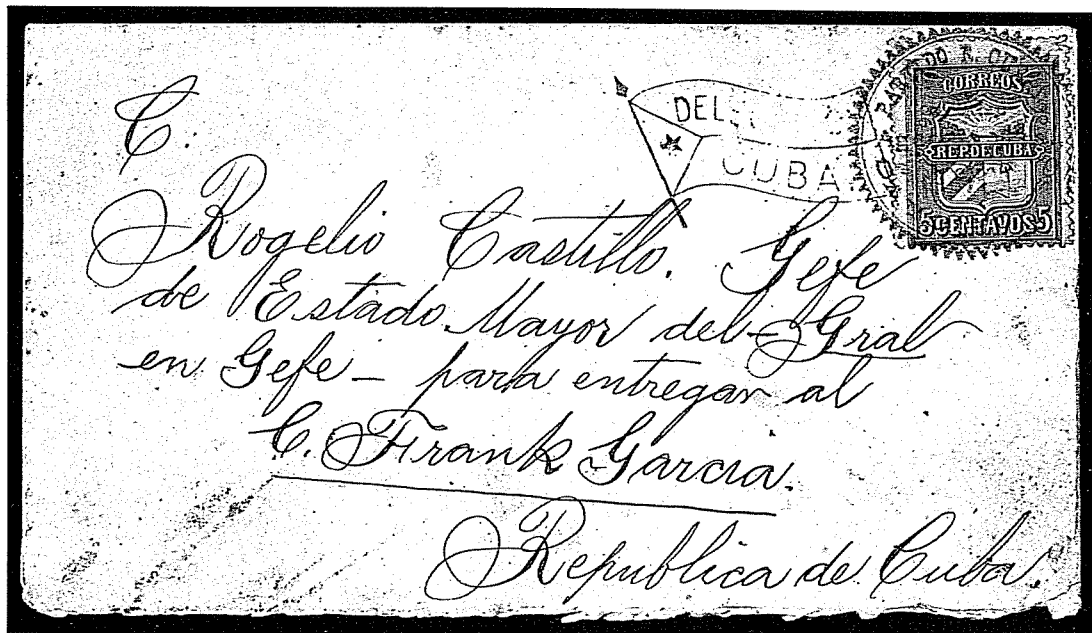

With the declaration of war on Spain by the U.S. on April 26, 1898, all previous secret alliances with the Cuban revolutionary forces were no longer held secret and aid was extended openly. Forces operating on U.S. territory, including Key West (Cayo Heuso), evidently used postal markings, as shown by this unique example. This cover originated in Nassau, Bahamas, and passed through Key West en route to New York.

## PUERTO PRINCIPE PROVISIONAL SURCHARGES

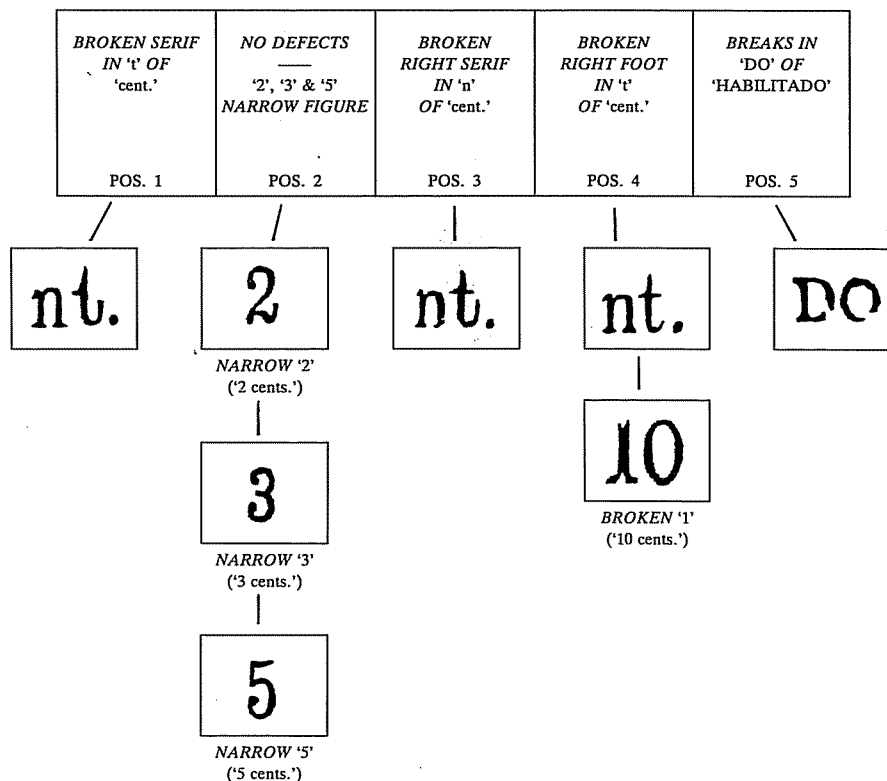
Following the sinking of the United States battleship 'Maine', in February, 1898, the American government demanded Spain's withdrawal from the island of Cuba and openly supported the revolutionary forces that had previously received covert aid. The resulting Spanish-American War was quickly ended by the swift American naval conquests, and in December, 1898, a peace treaty was signed, by which Spain lost possession of Cuba. On January 1, 1899, the U.S. military authority over Cuba commenced, lasting until 1902, when the new independent government assumed control.

The district of Puerto Principe, now called Camagüey, was forced to issue surcharged postage stamps in December, 1898, when supplies of five denominations of United States Administration stamps were not available, due in part to the late arrival (November 24) of American troops in this island province. These Puerto Principe provisionals—1, 2, 3, 5 and 10-cent stamps—were printed by one man, after nightfall, at the offices of the local newspaper. The word 'Habilitado' and denomination were overprinted on horizontal strips of Spanish colonial issues, using a hand press with a setting of five individual surcharges. Many errors, in both composition and production, were made because of poor lighting and the lack of print-type.

Five different printings of the Puerto Principe provisionals were made. Every setting has been successfully reconstructed, and the printing characteristics of each of the five distinct printings have been accurately determined. Therefore, the catalog listing in Scott reflects not only the simple surcharge value and type of stamp, but also the distinct characteristics of certain printings and positions in the setting. This basic logic of the Puerto Principe issue must be understood before any attempt is made to study or collect the 44 major Scott-listed stamps.

The following description of the three surcharge settings and their variations, combined with tables presenting all of the major Scott-listed stamps produced from the five printings, will serve as a useful reference when reading lot descriptions in this catalog. All numbers used in the tables are borrowed from the Scott Catalog, in accordance with the publisher's copyright restrictions.

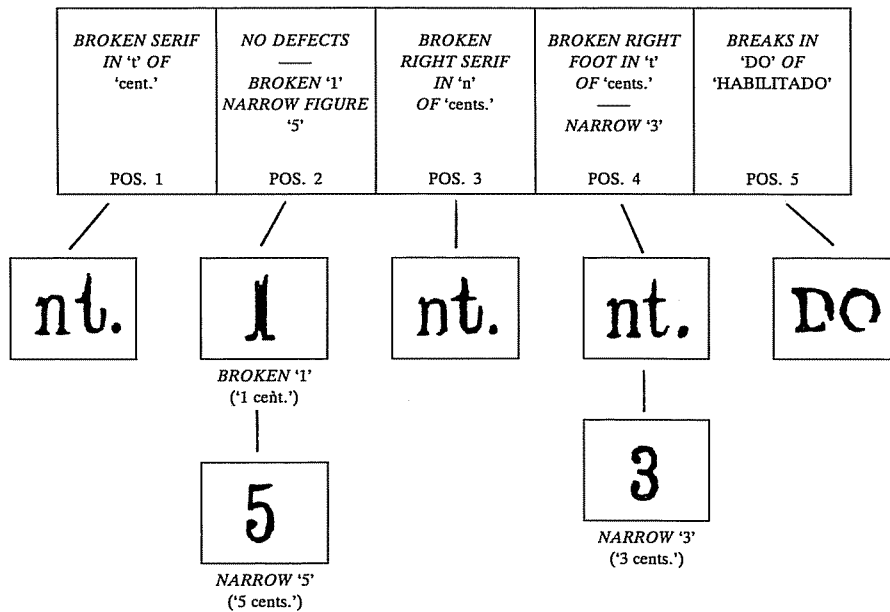

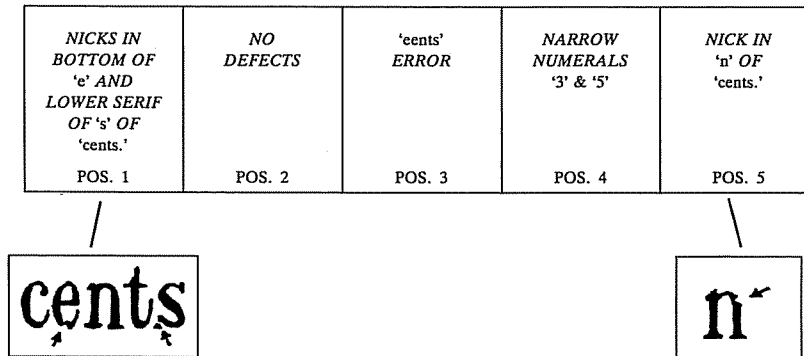

MULTIPLES

Owing to the method of surcharging, it is not possible to have vertical strips or blocks. No multiple larger than a strip of five is known, so it seems likely that the stamps were divided into strips of five before surcharging.

Any pair or multiple is scarce, especially those showing combinations of types. Of the scarcer issues, pairs or strips are extremely rare, and in many cases no multiple is recorded.

## SURCHARGED GUTTER AND SELVAGE VARIETIES

One of the unusual features of the Puerto Principe provisionals is the presence of blank gutter 'labels' or selvage with the surcharge. The reason for these oddities lies in the circumstance of issue and the sheet formats of the basic Spanish colonial issues.

The surcharge setting could only be applied to horizontal strips of five stamps at a time. The obsolete Spanish colonial stamps could not be purchased from the Spanish post office, but instead had to come from other sources. As a result, any stamps in sheets or part sheets were used. First, the Orange Brown values were surcharged; then, the Black Violet stamps; finally, the Blue Green Newspaper issues were used.

In order to surcharge a strip of five, it was sometimes necessary to include selvage or a blank gutter label in the strip. For example, if one had a 'scrap' of the Orange Brown sheet containing four stamps and a piece of selvage, the entire piece would be surcharged. The Black Violet sheets contained ten vertical rows, separated between the fifth and sixth stamps by a gutter. As illustrated in the previous example, it was occasionally necessary to apply the entire surcharge setting to stamps and selvage or gutter combined. The Blue Green Newspaper stamps came in sheets of 200, with a vertical format of 6 rows-gutter-8 rows-gutter-6 rows. Obviously, this format created at least one blank surcharged gutter for every horizontal row of stamps surcharged.

Although the blank surcharges were not valid for postage, they were sometimes left intact. Therefore, it is possible to find various combinations of stamps and blank surcharges; such items are very rare.

## PUERTO PRINCIPE COVERS

The provisional stamps were valid from December 19, 1898, through January 22, 1899. Covers demonstrating usage of these stamps are extremely rare—less than 25 are currently recorded, 12 of which are contained in this collection. Included in this offering are a First Day Cover (December 19), covers to India and Germany (only recorded usages), the Third Printing 10c on cover with a Fifth Printing 5c (the only recorded 10c cover and one of four Fifth Printing covers), the Fifth Printing 3c (only recorded cover) and the famous Fifth Printing 5c pair, the only recorded multiple from this printing on cover.

## A NOTE CONCERNING CONDITION

Collectors familiar with the Puerto Principe issue accept faults as a characteristic condition. The paper upon which Spanish colonial stamps were printed was very soft and fibrous, and, therefore, is usually thinned. Gum toning, due to climatic conditions in Cuba, is often present in unused and even used copies, especially those on piece. The perforations on the colonial stamps were poorly manufactured, and, therefore, rough or missing perforations are the norm.

## RARITY AND PRICING

The Puerto Principe provisionals present one of the most difficult areas for a professional to estimate in market terms. Obviously, stamps of which there are a half dozen or less copies known—or unique, as in a few cases in this offering—are not frequently traded in the marketplace, and, therefore, are difficult to price.

The Scott Catalog prices are based primarily on the last important auction sale of these issues, the John C. Juhring sale held by Stanley Gibbons Merkur in Germany in 1978. Where the rest of the stamp market has moved ahead, the Puerto Principe issues have not, at least in terms of the Scott Catalog prices. For example, the Fourth Printing 5-cent on 5m surcharge sold in the 1978 Juhring sale for approximately \$3,500 (at the then current exchange rate, plus commissions). It was first priced in the Scott Catalog in 1981 at \$4,000 and has since remained at that level. In our opinion, inflation alone has made this valuation obsolete.

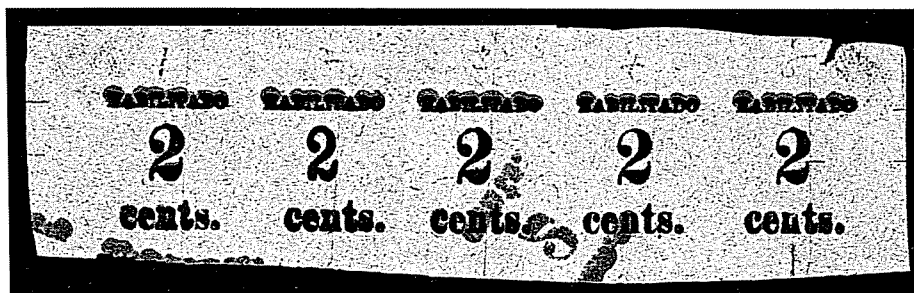
Similarly, the rare pairs, strips and on-cover usages, for which there are no catalog valuations, have been estimated in this catalog at levels matching or below the 1978 Juhring sale realizations, for the most part. Considering the uniqueness of many of these multiples and covers, our estimation of market value might well prove too modest.
